2024 CUMBERLAND COUNTY FAIR PRO STOCK LAWN MOWER RULES

PAYOUT: \$145, \$75, \$45, \$40

Frame

- 1. Non-craftsman frames without a front exhaust box (stub) will be allowed to build one with the same dimensions as a Craftsman stub (8" from the nose of the axle and 12" wide) out of 3"x3" angle iron
- 2. Exhaust plates my be up to 10"x5"x1/8" and welded top and bottom on two sides **ONLY**!!
- 3. No frame reinforcement aloud, you can plug and seam weld and fenders may be welded to the frame.
- 4. 10"x10"x1/8" engine plate that can be attached to the frame by (6) 3/8" bolts or welded on 2 sides, as well as 4 engine bolts
- 5. (3) 3x3x1/8" patch plates on a pre ran frame. Only 4 plates per frame. A mower with only (2) 3x3x1/4" plates will be allowed but nothing more can be added to the frame
- 6. Front bumper will be allowed No bigger than 4x4 and may have a point, must NOT be any wider than the inside of the front wheels.
- 7. NO back bumpers, back bars do not count as a bumper

Cage

- 1. 2x2 tubing or 2" pipe for cage material
- 2. Attach cage to frame at 4 points (2 on each side), directly I front of the running boards (cage not to extend past that point) You can weld the cage to running boards and fenders.
- 3. 1 cross bar aloud above the hood and another in front of the seat. NO belly bars allowed
- 4. 1/8" sheet metal on leg guards
- 5. Back bar MUST BE at least as wide and as tall as the seat and ONLY attached 2 places to the frame

Front Axle/steering

- 1. Cast iron axles are allowed but must be from the same mower brand
- 2. Factory spindles only, some reinforcements will be allowed
- 3. May weld or bolt front axle to prevent it from pivoting
- 4. Heim joints are allowed

Transaxle

- 1. Up 1" transaxles allowed, $\frac{3}{4}$ " transaxle will be allowed an axle brace
- 2. May lock spider gears
- 3. Pulley swapping is allowed
- $4.\ \text{Rear}$ wheels not to exceed 12" and no smaller than 6"

Hood

- 1. Seam welding, creasing and folding is allowed,
- 2. Plastic grilles can be replaced with sheet metal not thicker than the hood and must have head light holes.
- 3. Attach the hood to the dash with self-tapping screws or 3/8 bolts
- 4. May attach to the frame with 2 pieces of $\frac{3}{4}$ " all-thread or bolt straight to the frame using $\frac{3}{8}$ bolts
- 5. Not metal can be added to hood and must be able to see inside the hood

Engine

- 1. Vertical shaft lawn mower engines only
- 2. Spark plug and carb. Guards allowed (must be attached to the engine or engine plate
- 3. Exhaust must go up or down in a safe manner

Fuel tank

- 1. Secure your tanks in a location that it cannot be damaged.
- 2. NO tanks under the seat
- 3. MUST have a fuel shut off valve

Wheels

Any tread style will be allowed and tires must have air in them
