

\$ 1200 - \$ 400 - \$ 300 - \$ 200

1. Battery goes in front floorboard.
2. Gas can in rear floorboard
3. Trunk may not be flattened to the frame or wedged. No hump plates
4. You may weld all 4 doors.
5. 3/4 all thread may be used for body mounts and you may have 2 - 3/4 all threads in trunk 2 in hood through frame or no. 9 wire 2 strands in 4 places on hood.
6. For safety, a driver's side bar, not to exceed 40" past bottom*** rear of driver's seat. You may use spreader bars on both sides, safety cages may be fastened to frame of the vehicle with straight down bars. All cages not to exceed 40" past bottom rear of driver's seat. Dash rear, and side bars must be welded in or bolted.
7. Bumpers may be welded directly to the frame-if so no bumper mounts are allowed-if not you may have a 4x4 mounting bracket 12" long for bumper. Mounts may be welded solid to frame on the outside (NEED TO HAVE A SAFETY CHAIN WELDED OR BOLTED TO BUMPER THAT CONNECTED TO THE FRAME ON BOTH SIDES FOR SAFETY TO KEEP BUMPER FROM FLYING OFF).
8. You may use or reinforce any original car bumper or you may use a replicate car bumper but it must stay within factory specifications. Front and back bumper need to stay close to original height.
9. Needs to be a factory rear end (no bigger than a 6 lug)(no over built rear ends or suspensions) 15" tires max. May run forklift tires, must have air. Welded wheels with multi lug holes allowed. Pinion breaks allowed. Slider shafts allowed.
10. You may have after-market shifter and foot feet.
11. You may swap engine...all engines must be stock.
12. May have lower engine cradle.
13. Front window bars are allowed.
14. You may replace steering column.
15. Gas tank protector no further back than 40" from bottom of front seat - must stay in front of rear axle.
16. You may have 6 patch plates 3 on each side 6 inches long. 6" x 6"
