1. No Imperials, Suicide door Lincolns, Hearses, 4x4 vehicles, or Convertibles will be allowed.
2. All vehicles must be stock framed and bodied, but motor swaps are allowed no modified engines *** or transmissions No extra reinforcements may be made to frames or bodies, no welds anywhere but front bumper ***and doors may be welded shut.
3. All doors are to be fastened shut by #9 wire or chain. You may weld your doors shut. If wiring is used, no more than two (2) strands of #9 wire may be used per hole. Only one (1) run of chain per hole and must be fastened securely by welding of chain or bolting. Stock class may weld doors!
4. Hood and trunk may be fastened shut in six (6) places total. Two (2) strands of #9 wire per hole, per location. You may wire around frames. Wiring to the front bumper in two (2) places only. Wiring may not be located in front of or behind radiator. Trunk lids and tailgates may be fastened shut using #9 wire or chain in no more than 6 places.
5. Any Factory bumpers and mountings are allowed. AU bumpers and mountings must look stock. Weld your bumpers and mounts. No skid plates are allowed.
6. For safety, a driver's side bar, not to exceed 32" past bottom ***rear of drivers seat. You may use spreader bars on both sides, but safety cages may only be fastened to sheet metal and may not be attached to the floor or frame of the vehicle with down bars. All cages not to exceed 32" past bottom rear of drivers seat. Dash, rear, and sidebars must be welded in or bolted.
7. There must be a bend or rusted frame in order to use a patch to frame. Inspection holes must remain open. 6 inch patch may be used on one side of frame, front, and back a total of 6 patches. No adding anything to the inside of frames, (Concrete, Steel, Wood, etc.) Hump plates for rear frames will not be allowed.
8. No Imperial sub-frames will be allowed. Keep the height of the vehicle reasonable. This will be to judges' discretion.
9. Stock rear ends and axles only! Rear ends may be welded, posi-traction, or stock,
10. No tires larger than 16". Rims must be free of wheel weights, No 6 or 8 lug rims. No split rims, and no studded tires. Water is allowed. ***No solid tires must have air.
11. NO Double Tires
12. ANY ADD ON STOCK BUPMER CANNOT BE MODIFIED IN ANY WAY! NO Replicas (aftermarket)
YOU MAY:

- Weld Trunks
- Run 3 speed transmissions
- 4 x 4 square front bumper only must be skinned, maybe welded direct to frame, NO pointy bumpers built
- 2 – 3/4 all threads may be used in hood may go through frame and hood
- May Weld Bumper to Frame
- May have Lower Cradle
- May Weld Seams on Frame
- May Replace Body Bolts
- Have slider shafts
- Bought shifters are allowed
- Replace steering columns
- Replace foot feeds
