All entries must be on the grounds 1-hour prior to show!

**\$40 entry fee for Stock Class; \$25 entry fee for Passenger
The following are Stock Class Compact Rules.**

1. **105" Wheel Base or Less.**
2. All vehicles must be stock framed and bodied, but motor swaps are allowed no modified engines. No extra reinforcements may be made to frames or bodies, **no welds anywhere but front bumper and doors.**
3. All doors are to be fastened shut by #9 wire or chain or weld. **No welding trunks in Stock Class.** If wiring is used, **no more than two (2) strands of #9 wire may be used per hole.** Only one (1) run of chain per hole and must be fastened securely by welding of chain or bolting. *****You may weld doors in stock class.**
4. Front and rear hoods may be fastened shut **in six (6) places total.** Two (2) strands of #9 wire per hole, per location. You may wire around frames. Wiring to the front bumper in two (2) places only. Wiring may not be located in front of or behind radiator. Trunk lids and tailgates may be fastened shut using #9 wire or chain in no more than 6 places.
5. **Any Factory Car bumpers and mountings are allowed, no pointy bumpers.** AU bumpers and mountings must look stock. Weld your bumpers and mounts. No skid plates are allowed. **Rear wheel drive cars bumper mounts must be on outside of frame and no direct welding bumper to frame must have mount.**
6. No Distributor protectors or engine cradles. Engine and transmission mounts maybe welded or chained. For safety, a driver's side bar, **not to exceed 32" past the bottom rear of front seat** and must be used. You may use spreader bars on both sides, but safety cages may only be fastened to sheet metal and may not be attached to the floor or frame of the vehicle with down bars. **All cages not to exceed 32" past bottom rear of driver's seat.** Dash, rear, and sidebars must be welded in or bolted.
7. **Frame seams may not be welded on stock Class** and inspection holes must remain open. 3 inch patch may be used on one side of frame, front, and back a total of 4 patches, **there must be a bend or rust hole in frame in order to put a 3" plate on one side of frame.** No adding anything to the inside of frames, (Concrete, Steel, Wood, etc.) Hump plates for rear frames will not be allowed in stock class.
8. Keep the height of the vehicle reasonable. This will be to judges' discretion. Cars must have bounce to them. You may chain rear ends or wire them in place.
9. Stock rear ends and axles only! Rear ends may be welded, posi-traction, or stock,
10. Front wheel drive cars only may add a 4 by 4 by quarter inch square bumper to the front and back must have skin on it.
11. **NO Solid Tires – all tires must have air.**
12. **NO Slider Shaft's**
13. **NO Double Tires**
14. **NO V8 Engines**
15. **NO Tires larger than 15"**
16. **NO Split Rims**
17. **NO All Threads or Bolts in Hood or Trunk**
18. **NO Pointed Bumpers**
