- No Imperials, Suicide door Lincolns, Hearses, 4x4 vehicles, or Convertibles will be allowed.
- All vehicles must be stock framed and bodied, but motor swaps are allowed.
- All doors are to be fastened shut by #9 wire, chained, or welded.
- Hood may be fastened shut in six (6) places total. Two (2) strands of #9 wire per hole, per location. You may wire around frames. Wiring to the front bumper in tow (2) places only. 2- ¾ all thread one on each side and may go through the frame may be used on either side of the radiator support. Trunk lids may be fastened shut using #9 wire, chain, or weld, you may use 2 all thread 1 on each side ¾ inch, can go through the frame.
- Any Factory bumper and mountings are allowed. You may build, 4 x 4 square front bumper with 8" point, maybe welded direct to frame. ANY ADD ON STOCK BUMPER MAYBE LOADED! **Replica's aftermarket bumpers are allowed.**
- For safety, a driver's side bar, not to exceed 32" past bottom***rear of driver's seat. You may use spreader bars on both sides, but safety cages may only be fastened to sheet metal and may not be attached to the floor or frame of the vehicle with down bars. All cages not to exceed 32" past bottom rear of driver's seat. Dash, rear, and sidebars must be welded in or bolted.
- Frame seams may be welded, and inspection holes must remain open. There must be a bend or rusted frame in order to use a use a patch to frame. 6-inch patch may be used on one side of the frame, front, and back a total of 6 patches, 3 on each side. No adding anything to the inside of frames (Concrete, Steel, Wood, Etc.) Hump plates for rear frames will **not** be allowed.
- No Imperial sub-frames will be allowed. Keep the height of the vehicle reasonable. This will be to judges' discretion.
- Stock rear ends and axles only! Rear ends may be welded. Must have factory mounts and springs.
- No tires larger than 16". Rims must be free of wheel weights, No 6 or 8 lug rims. No split rims, and no studded tires. Water is allowed. No solid tires must have air.
- **NO Double Tires**

YOU MAY:

- Have slider shafts
- Replace steering columns
- Run 3 speed transmission
- Bought shifters are allowed
- Replace foot feeds
- May have Lower Cradle
- May Replace Body Bolts (maybe welded direct to frame.
- No aftermarket ball joints or A-arms
- No Rear End Protectors

No Exceptions on these Rules...
