

1. Mower must be a factory available lawn mower. (No homemade frames)
2. No rear engine lawn mowers are allowed.
3. Must be a factory lawn mower engine such as Briggs & Stratton, Kohler, Tecumseh, Onan, etc.
4. Transaxles must be factory available lawn mower transaxle, but any reinforcing and/or welding of spider gears may be permitted.
5. All lawn mowers must have good working brakes at the start of the heat.
6. Gas tanks must be secured and have a cap on it. Must run a on/ off shut off for safety if leaking you will be asked to shut down.
7. Frame modifications are allowed you can have 2x2 1/4 max tubing or plate from front of frame to beginning of foot pan... rear section of frame from back of footrest to end of frame can have 2x2 1/4 thick max tubing or plate. If you have full tubing front to back you will be asked to cut.
8. Engine Bay reinforcement is permitted under the hood. You may use 2x2 1/4 max tubing from front plate to leg guards as a "kicker" you must be able to hit front tire. If abused, you will lose it.
9. Cage cannot exceed over a 26" measurement from bottom of cage bar to top of cage bar on front and sides of cage.
10. Front bumper can only be 26 inches long and no larger than a 4x4 square tubing. You are not allowed to double stack tubing for bumpers. Front bumpers have a max extension off the front of the factory frame of 5" to the back of the bumper. You may have rear bumper but must be within the outside of rear tires.
11. Must run factory hood of lawn mower if hood is fiberglass replace it with an all-metal factory available lawn mower hood.
12. Any lawn mower tire wheel combo allowed. No tire chains or dual wheels.
13. Aftermarket headers, gas pedal, shifter are permitted. Please make sure shifter is mounted in a safe place so it can't be hit.
14. A small back plate is permitted must be within inside of fenders. Don't go overboard.
15. No hitting in rear of lawn mower. If caught hitting in the back of the mower you will be warned once, then will be out. This is considered a driver's door.
16. NO DRAMA. Don't show up trying to hurt someone or fight.
17. Roll-over driver is out of heat. If driver hand or foot touches ground, you will be considered out.
18. Batteries are permitted but must be secured down and will be checked.
19. Please put your number on both sides of the mower visible for officials to read and track winners.
20. We will go over all ground rules in a mower driver meeting before the heat.
